# CHISEL & MOUSE FOR SIR JOHN SOANE'S MUSEUM

Sir John Soane was an avid collector and, amid his array of precious antiquities and artworks, he owned around 175 intricate architectural models of ancient and contemporary buildings. Robert and Gavin Paisley of Chisel & Mouse have been casting miniature representations of buildings and landmarks since 2011, and have recently released replicas of three models in Sir John Soane's collection: Monument of Mylasa, Monument of Palmyra and Temple of Artemis the Huntress.
