André Masson, 1968

André Masson commenced his artistic studies at the Academic Royale des Beaux Arts in Brussels, before moving to Paris in 1912 to continue his studies at the Ecole Supérieure des Beaux Arts and eventually moving to United States amid the outbreak of World War II. This vibrant and visually dynamic piece was central to the artist's ongoing exploration of Greek mythology, telling the story of the newly born Zeus and conveying the extremes of human emotion through both tragedy and comedy.
